Discussion

Egypt is both 'Black land' and 'Red Land' – what does that mean? Which land would be described as a “wild place” and why?

The children of God were led by God through Moses during the Exodus wilderness journey. God instructed them to build a (MIKDASH/ MISHKAN) sanctuary or tabernacle. What was God's desire and how is that different from other gods? (Exodus 25:8)

In this lesson George introduced the word for “holy” (KADOSH). God said: “you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation” (EX 19:6; 1 Peter 2:5) What does this use of the word 'holy' mean for believers?

Read: Joshua chapter 2:9-11 -- What was Rehab's observation about the chosen people of God?

Yes, sin separates us from God, but what else did you learn about your relationship with God and His desire?

What are examples of wild wilderness places in your life and the lives of others?

Even in wild places, how does God embrace you ?

Life can be seen as a series of wilderness experiences, what must believers always be doing?
